I am interested in time, the apparent dilatability and unrestness of time, the intensity and extension of a moment in its transience. These collected perceptions are shown in installative works in space with material, drawings and videos. In addition a diversed media enters into a interconnection with space, being always arranged in a new way.

For many years I have also been working with the history of time and Earth, as it can be found in the oil shale rock from the foothills of the Swabian Alb. I am fascinated by rock and earth, as well as the forces of nature, water and air, which have inscribed their traces into our Earth history. Preserved materials, archived memories.

The installation was developed from a drawing. Grey, black and white lines, applied to rolls of Japanese paper, create an apparent chaos of lines and supposed (dis)order. The water, with which the watercolour is mixed comes from a river, the Thames in London. There was the installation on view in October 2019 to January 2020 the exhibition Contemplations at Stables Gallery, London-Twickenham.

The striking lines, drawn strictly with a ruler, are associated with lines drawn exclusively with water, they overlap and break the system. These water-line-interventions, like flow of water in general, build an almost invisible something that leaves traces in the form of subtle changes in the paper. The arrangement of the four paper rolls is done in a way that might remind of flowing movements, a meandering stream. The play with the title, which is an expression, and as much as "swimming with the current" means, hints out to numerous properties of water and man. Water flows, water is alive, water crosses borders.







Engadin Map













River 2018 Drawing, ink on paper and substances from the river Series of five sheets, 30×42 cm each


Hearing, perceiving, transferring sounds and rhythms in lines on paper. Recording the sound produced by drawing with a graphite pen on paper. Recording the movements of the drawing. Transformation of the sound into new pieces of music/compositions, to which again is drawn. For quite some time now, I've been drawing on music, not with music that just runs in the background. Concentrated, I try to perceive exactly what I hear and then transfer the sounds in lines onto the paper. Combined with high concentration and body tension, arising large-format drawings with numerous layers of graphite. Drawing with the graphite pencil produces a sound that is recorded with the camera. Also recorded are the dynamic movements of my arm, as it loops and draws itself over the space defined by the size of the sheet. So far, three large-format drawings have been created.






















But Don't Vanish is (moving) image, words and sound. An experimental film that suggests different levels of time and space. Time seems to stand still in some places, strongly condensed in others, and with the naked eye it is sometimes no longer comprehensible what is happening. The sentences, which run fragmentarily linearly through the film, provide support. *Don't disappear* could be a possible translation of But Don't Vanish, reminding us of the transience of our existence, pointing to deep, unconscious fears. The almost unbearable slowness, the unexpected silence and blurriness that appear in some parts of the film create a sense of loss of control. The formerly wild, romantic idea of nature has long since been shaken; for thousands of years man has been intervening in and destroying natural systems. On the other hand, man often sees nature as an undefined, alien danger and creates systems that can be controlled. Evoked by numerous images, as well as by various sounds of water, which have been amplified, changed and reinterpreted, slowness, beauty and silence face unknown chaos and unconscious depth.
